
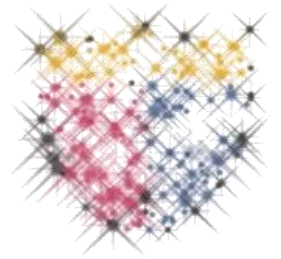

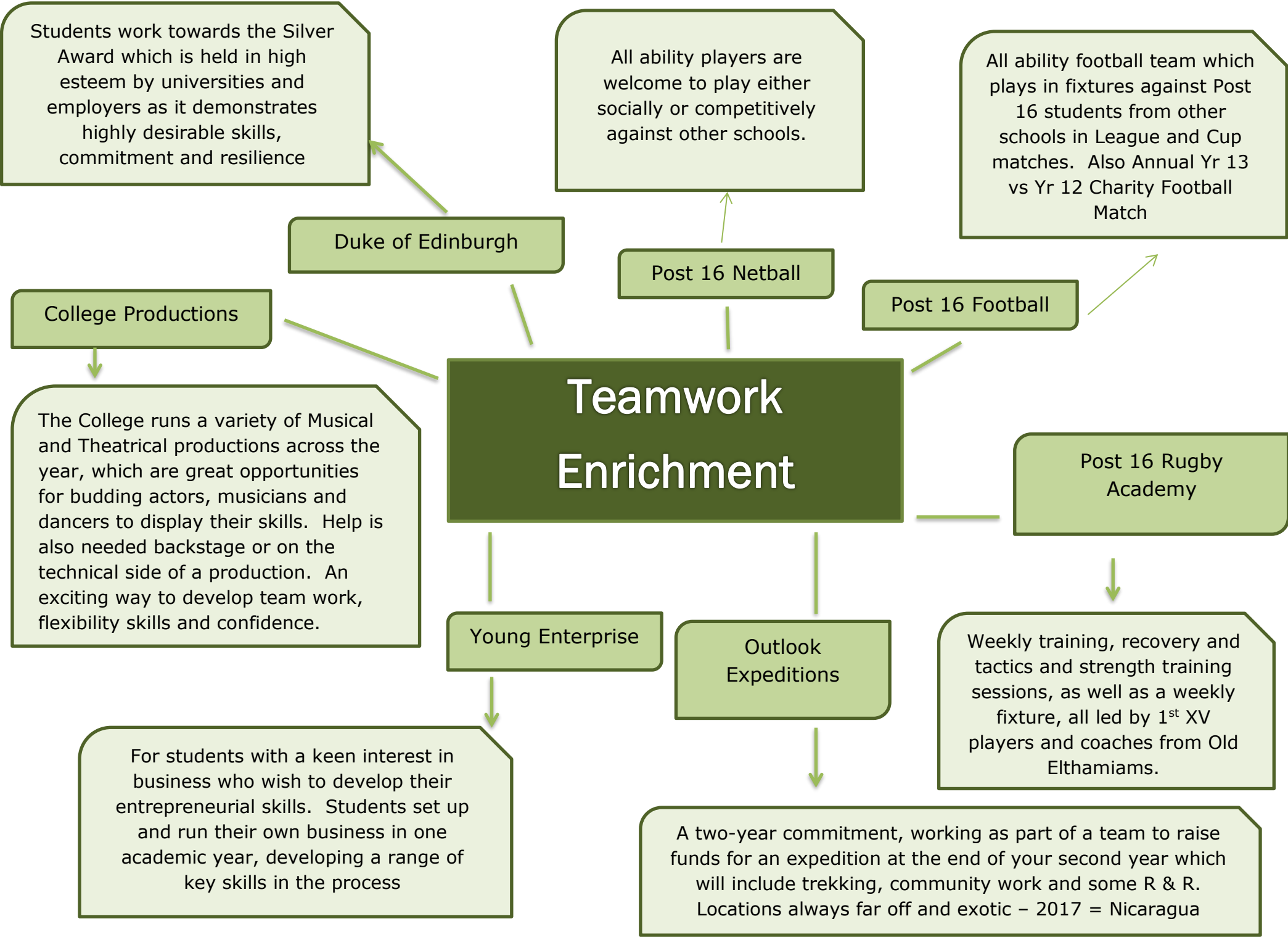
If you have a passion for new things, the online courses available on 'Future Learn' will be just what you are looking for.
