### Re: Year 12 and 13 Residential visit to Paris inc. Disneyland Paris and Rex Movie Studios

I am pleased to inform you that we are arranging a residential visit to Paris, France for Media and Film Studies students from Monday 1 July to Wednesday 3 July 2019 during our Activities Week. During the visit the group will experience The Art of Disney Animation, a Studio Tram Tour, Stunt Show Armageddon Special effects, Cinemagique and the Rock and Roll Rollercoaster at Disneyland Paris as well as a tour of the famous Rex Movie Studios, Paris and the opportunity to visit some of the unique sights of Paris, such as the Eiffel Tower. This will be a unique opportunity for any student interested in the world of film, television and animation, or a future in broadcast media.

We will be travelling with Travelbound, an ABTA and ATOL protected company. The cost of the trip will be **£305** per person. This includes the use of an Executive Coach, return channel crossings, group travel and medical insurance, two nights half-board accommodation at a Paris hotel, motorway tolls and taxes and planning services provided by Travelbound, and of course entrance to the Disney experience.

If you wish your child to participate in this trip, Travelbound requires a non-refundable deposit of **£40** to secure your child's place on the trip to be paid by Friday 30 November 2018, with the remaining payments to be paid in instalments, with the next payment due in January. There will be a meeting nearer the time to confirm a final itinerary and to answer any questions.

Please be aware that places are currently limited to 30 and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. We will also take into consideration the disciplinary record of the student. Please also ensure that your child has a valid passport with at least six months left on it at the time of the trip. An EHC health insurance card will also be required for all students.

If you would like your child to take up this exciting opportunity, please fill out the consent form attached and return to us. Your first deposit instalment should be paid via the school's payment system, WisePay which is accessible from the Coopers School homepage.

The Media and English department are very much looking forward to accompanying your child on this trip.
