Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Activities Week Trip for Year 9 to Thorpe Park on 6 July

We are delighted your child has chosen to visit Thorpe Park as part of our Activities Week in July. Thorpe Park is one of the UK's major theme parks, with several roller-coasters, water rides and games. This will be a fun and exciting day out for students.

Students will need to meet in the Sports Hall at 8.15am to be registered and we will be departing at 8.30am. Students will need to meet back at the allocated meeting point at 2.30pm to be registered again before departure at 3.00pm. We aim to be back at school by 5.00pm.

We will be travelling to and from the park by coach, and the cost of the trip includes both the entrance to the park and the coach travel. Students will be expected, as representatives of the school, to behave in an exemplary manner. Students should wear their own, suitable clothes.
