Re: Activities Week trip for Year 7 to Horniman Museum, London – Thursday 5 July

On Thursday 5 July 2018, we are pleased to invite all Year 7 students not involved in the cinema trip to attend an outing to the Horniman Museum, London.

The Horniman is a free museum with extensive collections of anthropology, natural history and musical instruments. The museum hosts a variety of special exhibitions, concerts, festivals, shows, workshops and activities. We will be exploring as many of these as possible, and making use of the extensive gardens (weather permitting).

The cost of students' travel, via public transport, has been covered. Students should attend in full school uniform, but may wear trainers, as the trip will involve some walking. A coat or waterproof is advised if the weather is likely to be poor. Students will be escorted back to school, and will not have permission to make their own way home from either the venue or from Chislehurst station.

Students may wish to make purchases in the shop and café; however, these are expensive. A packed lunch and drink would be a more suitable alternative.

Students should report to the English Department at 8.30am on the morning of Thursday 5 July. We will aim to return to school by 3.00pm. Please note that students who fail to meet standards and expectations regarding behaviour prior to the visit will have the privilege of participating in the visit withdrawn.
