Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Activities Week Trip for Year 8 to Thorpe Park – Tuesday 3 July

We are delighted to offer students in Year 8 the opportunity to visit Thorpe Park as part of our Activities Week in July. Thorpe Park is one of the UK's major theme parks, with several roller-coasters, water rides and games. This will be a fun and exciting day out for students.

We will be travelling to and from the park by coach – the cost of this trip is £40 which includes both the entrance to the park and coach travel. Students should wear their own, suitable clothes. Comfortable footwear is essential as students will spend most of the day walking around the park, and a coat or waterproof is advised in the event of wet weather. Students may also get very wet if they choose to go on the water rides and may wish to bring a change of clothes.

Students can purchase food and drinks at the park, although this can be expensive, and a packed lunch, drink and snack may be a more suitable alternative. They may also bring a small amount of money to spend in the gift shops.

Students wishing to take part in the trip will be expected, as representatives of the school, to behave in an exemplary manner. Students who fail to meet the standards and expectations regarding behaviour prior to the visit will have the privilege of participating in the visit withdrawn and we will be unable to refund payment.
