Re: The Brilliant Club Graduation – King's College London

We are delighted to invite your child to attend a graduation event at King's College London on 14 July 2018. The graduation event celebrates your child's hard work on the Scholars Programme. The Scholars Programme has involved your child working closely with a PhD Tutor, who is either studying to gain a PhD or already has one, in a series of small group university-style tutorials to study a 'super-curricular' course that explores topics they may not usually study in the school curriculum.

Your child has completed an extended final assignment that has challenged them to work above their current key stage. The Graduation Event will take place at Bush House, King's College London on the afternoon of Saturday 14 July 2018. The event is run in partnership with the host university and will involve a study skills session, the chance to meet and ask questions of current students, advice and guidance from the university and a formal certification ceremony where they will receive a certificate to acknowledge and celebrate their achievements on the programme.

Parents and Carers are invited to attend the trip. We ask for no more than one Parent/Carer per student to ensure all the students' families can be represented.
