RE: Trip to Move IT 2018 at Excel London – Friday 16 March 2018

I am writing to invite your son or daughter to Move it 2018 at Excel London on Friday 16 March 2018. We successfully ran this trip last year and are offering it exclusively to Year 8, 9 and 10 Dance students this year. This is a reward trip for dancers who have consistently shown their commitment in lessons and to build on their knowledge of other styles and understand the professionalism of dance.

MOVE IT is the UK's biggest dance event and the whole day will allow students to take part in one big celebration of all things: classes, performances, career route advice, workshops and shopping.

These classes will help students progress through their dance course and encourage students to be versatile when performing. The following classes are included in the itinerary of the day:

- Hip Hop with Bird College at 11.30am
- Ilanga Gal Dem present Afrodancehall at 2.30pm

We will depart from Coopers at 9.00am and aim to return to Chislehurst station by 5.00pm. We only have a limited number of 25 spaces available to students which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The cost of this trip is £24.00 which includes the entry ticket and workshop entry to the two classes. Food and travel expenses will be additional. We are hoping to provide all students with TfL tickets to the venue but please be advised they should still bring their Oyster card in case of any unexpected problems with this.

Students do not need to wear uniform for this trip, but are expected to wear clothing they are able to dance in or come with a change of clothes, although there may not be enough time to change during the day. Please remind your child that they will be representing the school at all times. Participants are required to bring a packed lunch and may bring a small amount of spending money if they wish to purchase food, or to shop around the various stands available on the day.
