Re: The Pan London Youth Day – Thursday 21 June 2018 at Alexandra Palace

I am excited to announce that your child has been invited to attend the above event. The organisers of the Youth and Public Services Day have invited young people from every Secondary school and college from all of the 32 London Boroughs. Students will have a chance to meet and discuss opportunities that are available academically, culturally, socially and career-wise, in a safe environment, with organisations from the private, public and voluntary sector, as well as people with a history of achievement in their chosen field of work. There will be information stands by the Metropolitan Police Service, the other Emergency Services and Armed Forces, staffed by personnel who will be on hand to offer advice, together with voluntary and private sector organisations offering careers advice and more.

Additionally, there will be staff from Premiership football clubs including Tottenham Hotspur and from the world of Rugby Union – Saracens RFC Foundation giving young people advice and guidance on career and job opportunities within professional football, rugby and sport. Within the arena there will be a number of attractions, stands and displays from an array of groups as well as some junior boxing and fitness.

The day will open at 10.30am with a welcome from a senior-ranking Metropolitan Police officer at 11.00am. A free lunch will be provided for the students attending with the day planned to end at 2.30pm.

Students do not need to wear school uniform for this event, but we must insist on no ripped jeans and no cropped tops. Everybody should meet in the Canteen at 8.30am and a register will be taken. We will be travelling via public transport to Alexandra Palace from Chislehurst Station. Free travel will be provided for the event.

The event is due to finish at 2.30pm and we will return to school again via public transport. All students will be dismissed from school at approximately 4.15pm.
