### Re: Trip to Walt Disney Studios in Paris: Monday 2 July – Wednesday 4 July 2018

I am writing to you with news of an exciting opportunity for Media and Film Studies students. By popular demand we are planning to run a trip to the Walt Disney Studios in Paris. A visit to Walt Disney Studios® Park is a must for any Media or Film Studies student. During the visit, the group will experience the Art of Disney Animation, Animagique, a Studio Tram Tour: Behind the Magic, Stunt Show, Armageddon: Special Effects, CinéMagique, Disney Studio 1 and Rock 'n' Roller Coaster starring Aerosmith.

This will be a unique opportunity for any student interested in the world of film, television and animation, or a future in broadcast media. Students will also have the opportunity to visit some of the unique sights of Paris, such as the Eiffel Tower. This trip will run during Activities Week from Monday 2 – Wednesday 4 July 2018.

We will be travelling with Halsbury Travel, an ABTA and ATOL protected company, with over 30 years of experience of running school trips. We have previously used this company and have found the service to be excellent.

The cost of the trip will be **£245** per person. This includes the use of a coach for the duration of the trip, return Eurotunnel crossings, group travel and medical insurance, two nights bed and breakfast accommodation at a Paris hotel, motorway tolls and taxes, planning services provided by Halsbury Travel, a Seine boat trip and, of course, entrance to the Disney experience.

If you wish for your child to participate in this trip, Halsbury Travel requires a non-refundable deposit of **£75** to secure your child's place to be paid by Friday 12 January 2018, with the remaining payments to be made in instalments. There will be a meeting for all students attending and their parents/carers nearer the time to confirm a final itinerary and to answer any questions about the trip.

Please be aware that places are very limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and will also take into consideration the disciplinary record of the student.
