### Re: **Fear and Misery in the Third Reich** at Brockley Jack Theatre on Thursday 25 January

I have booked to take Year 12 Drama students to see 'Fear and Misery in the Third Reich' at Brockley Jack Theatre on Thursday 25 January.

Students are required to write about live performances they have seen as part of the Component 3 written exam for the A Level, and it is important that they see a variety of theatre in order to be able to write with knowledge and understanding. This production is especially interesting as the play is by Brecht, who is one of the practitioners they have studied already and will study again later in the course.

The cost is £12, and payment should be made through WisePay. We will meet at the theatre and students will be dismissed from there at the end of the performance – exact timings will be confirmed in due course. The theatre is a studio theatre located in The Brockley Jack Pub, 410 Brockley Road, London SE4 2DH.

The next theatre performance students will see will take place at Coopers – the brilliant 'Splendid Productions' will be performing their version of 'Metamorphosis' on Monday 12 March in the afternoon in our school hall. There will be a small charge of £5 towards the cost of this, and students will be able to participate in a question and answer session with the cast after the show. This performance will be loaded on to WisePay nearer the time. Mrs Ward and I will look for a further, contrasting production for the group to see in the summer term, which will mean that the Year 12 A Level class will have seen five contrasting pieces of live theatre in the first year of the course. This will stand them in very good stead as they tackle Component 3.
