RE: KS3 Shakespeare Lively Action workshop at The Globe - 30 November 2018

I am pleased to inform you of an exciting opportunity which your child has been invited to take part in. I have arranged for a group of Year 7 students to take part in a workshop called *Shakespeare's Language, Shakespeare's Stage*, an interesting initiative available for KS3 students at The Globe Theatre. This visit will take place on Friday 30 November and it consists of a 90 minute session including a half hour guided visit around the theatre, and a one hour workshop based on a Shakespeare play followed by a visit to an Exhibition.

During the workshop, students approach Shakespeare's plays through the context of the Globe playhouse. Through practical exploration, students are encouraged to develop an understanding of Shakespeare's characters and stories, and to engage with the text as a script for performance. Your child will benefit from this workshop as it supports national curriculum study of Shakespeare at Key Stage 3. Different dramatic techniques are used to explore Shakespeare's plays and deepen students' critical understanding.

The cost of this trip is £15 and we will travel by public transport. Please note that your child will be required to wear full school uniform and it is advisable for your child to have a packed lunch and a drink with them.
