# Entry to Higher Education in the UK

- Universities have long experience of accepting IB Diploma students
- HEI very positive attitude to DP applicants
- Outcomes are better than for A level students (Higher Education Statistics Agency research 2011 & 2016)
- Recent Ofqual perceptions survey showed 95% of HE respondents considered the IB was a good preparation for further studies, highest of any programme.

  - reflective

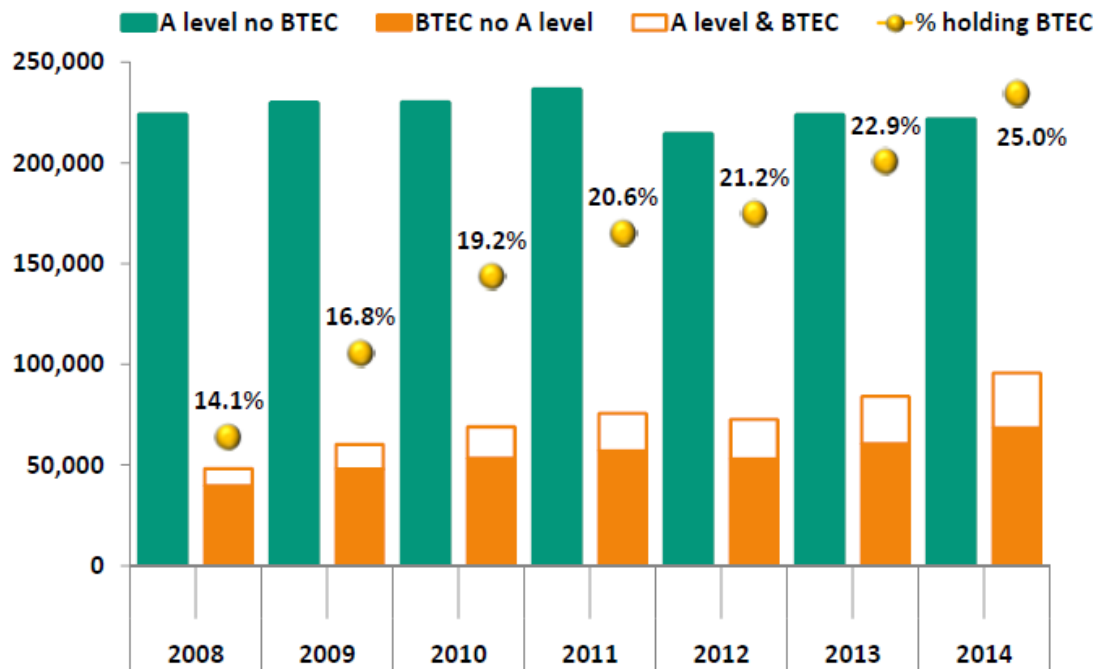


# UK HE Context
